- New students need to complete our <u>Admitted Student Survey</u> (the link was sent via email) to tell us your plans for Fall 2020



# Fall 2020 Enrollment Requirements Overview:

- 1. UNC Charlotte is offering online, in-person, and hybrid courses
- 2. <u>**Continuing**</u> students are eligible to enroll in an entirely online course load either within the U.S. or from abroad
- 3. Newly Admitted Students

I Lake A.

- a. Are eligible for a visa to enter the U.S. if they are enrolled in at least 1 class with an in-person component
- b. Are eligible to stay outside the U.S. and enroll in an entirely online course load
- 4. If the university moves to an entirely remote status at any point, continuing students will be able to remain within the U.S.





# **Timeline & Deadline re: Fall 2020**

- July 31st to complete the Financial Certification Form (FCF)
- August 1st to request to update your application for a future term for no cost
- September 7th First day of class at UNC Charlotte

 September 10th - Last day to arrive to Charlotte to start your studies at UNC Charlotte





# **Obtaining a visa, reviewing travel restrictions:**

- If you don't have a valid visa, can't get a flight, etc., you can keep trying, but this is out of the ISSO's control
- Active Travel advisories in effect for China, Iran, Brazil
- Schengen Zone, UK, Ireland: qualify for a National Interest Exception - See <u>CBP July 24th information Sheet</u>
  - 15 U.S. airports authorized to receive visitors from these areas
- Health & Safety Best practices after you enter the U.S. <u>CDC Travel</u>
   <u>precautions</u>

## **Recommended Arrival before September 10th**

- Arrive as early as possible, up to 30 days before I-20 start date
  - This allows you time to adjust before classes begin
- ISSO will support your arrival up to September 10th
  - So you can attend class and modify your schedule before the end of drop/add
- If you think you will arrive soon after September 10th
  - You must obtain permission in writing from your academic department indicating if they support your arrival after September 10th
- You must pay tuition if you are enrolled in classes on Sept 15th
  - Even if you forget to drop your classes

# **Full-Time Enrollment Required**

- If you are studying inside the U.S
- You must enroll full-time
  - 9 credits for graduate students
  - 12 credits for undergraduate students

- You must enroll in at least 1 hybrid or in-person class\*
- \*For Fall 2020, due to COVID-19, SEVP is allowing F-1 students to count more than 1 online class towards full-time enrollment



# Last minute visa issuance AFTER withdrawing Fall 2020 admission

If you obtain an "expedited" F-1 visa AFTER you have already applied for a future term, you can request readmission for Fall 2020. See our <u>email template</u> and list of requirements:

1. A copy of your F-1 visa

- 2. Written support from your graduate program director supporting your readmission for Fall 2020
- 3. Proof of additional funding if your original university funding is no longer available

4. Documentation that you can arrive on-campus by Sept 10.

# What if you obtain a visa, but can't arrive for Fall?

- Re-apply to UNC Charlotte for a future term
  - See slide 19 "Reapplying for a future term"
- Your Fall 2020 F-1 visa can be used for a future admit term along with an updated I-20
- The F-1 visa can be used to enter the U.S. up to the expiration date listed on the visa





# **Turning in your final transcript**

<u>November 1</u> - An official, final transcript showing proof of the bachelor's degree is required. Details will be emailed to you from the Office of Graduate Admissions.

# NOT Entering the U.S. For Fall 2020





## A. Not entering the U.S. - but studying online

- Online course availability varies by academic program
- Number of credits required
  - No minimum requirement

I Lake ....

- Status of I-20
  - We will reissue your I-20 with a Spring 2021 start date
- Tell us you will study online outside the U.S.
  - Complete our <u>Admitted Student Survey</u>
- Enrollment will NOT count towards the two semester

requirement to be eligible for CPT and or OPT



# **B.** Not entering the U.S. - and reapplying for a future term

- Action required
  - Reapply to UNC Charlotte

- New app fee required if you reapply after Aug 1st
- Drop Fall 2020 classes
  - You must pay tuition if you are enrolled on Sept 15th
- Status of I-20
  - Upload new Financial Certification Form (FCF)
    - Required if you were originally offered a graduate assistantship
    - Not required if you are 100% self/family funded
  - After admission, a new/updated I-20 will be generated

#### How Fall 2020 travel & enrollment impacts financial awards
