Test Scores & Slate

Following are helpful tips regarding test score requirements. The programs listed in the chart below are set-up in Slate to require a test and will populate on the application checklist.

To Remove a Test (or go test optional)

Submit a <u>Slate help ticket</u>, so we can do the work to change your program's set-up and update existing applications. This change will be effective for all terms, or whichever terms your program accepts applications. You will need to review three additional places to make sure information is updated accurately for your prospective students.

- Your webpage please let your prospects know whether or not you require a test.
- Graduate Catalog if the requirements for your program are incorrect, you will need to submit a curriculog proposal.
- Undergraduate Catalog if your programs offers early entry admission and your test requirements are incorrect, you will need to submit a curriculog proposal.

To Add a Test

Submit a <u>Slate help ticket</u>, so we can do the work to change your program's set-up and update existing applications. This change will be effective for all terms, or whichever terms your program accepts applications.

To Waive a Test for an Applicant
